What Is Covered

Protection for the combustion engine, the electric drive system and the supporting hybrid technology. Read this schedule with your Vehicle Warranty Terms and Conditions and your Validation Certificate.

It must also fail because of an eligible Mechanical Breakdown. The exclusions and claim conditions in your Vehicle Warranty Terms and Conditions still apply.

Combustion Powertrain

Covered components are listed below. Normal wear, routine maintenance and the exclusions in your Vehicle Warranty Terms and Conditions remain applicable.

Combustion engine

Protection for components contained within the cylinder block and cylinder head.

- ✓ Cylinder block and cylinder head
- ✓ Crankshaft and camshafts
- ✓ Pistons and connecting rods
- ✓ Internal bearings and moving parts
- ✓ Internal oil pump and timing components
- ✓ Valve-train components contained within the head
- ✗ Cracks and porosity are not covered

Final drive

Protection for the components that transfer power to the road wheels.

- ✓ Differential assembly
- ✓ Internal differential gears and bearings
- ✓ Drive shafts and half shafts
- ✓ Associated internal final-drive components

Transmission

Protection for components contained within the transmission assembly.

- ✓ Internal gears and gear assemblies
- ✓ Internal shafts and bearings
- ✓ Synchromesh components, where fitted
- ✓ Internal clutch packs and bands, where fitted
- ✓ Torque converter, where fitted
- ✓ Other internal mechanical transmission components

Fuel system

Protection for the listed fuel-delivery and injection components.

- ✓ Fuel pump
- ✓ Tank sender unit
- ✓ Fuel injectors
- ✓ Associated covered fuel-delivery components
- ✗ Filters are not covered
- ✗ Damage caused by poor-quality or contaminated fuel is not covered

Electric Drive and Battery

Covered components are listed below. Normal wear, routine maintenance and the exclusions in your Vehicle Warranty Terms and Conditions remain applicable.

Electric drive motor

Protection for components contained within the electric motor assembly.

- ✓ Rotor
- ✓ Stator
- ✓ Motor bearings
- ✓ Motor brushes, where fitted
- ✓ Internal motor components
- ✗ Wear-related failure is not covered

Motor control

Protection for the electronic units that control and communicate with the electric drive system.

- ✓ Electric-drive power-control units
- ✓ Motor-control electronics
- ✓ Drive-system communication units
- ✓ Associated covered control hardware

Motor power supply

Protection for the listed high-voltage motor supply components.

- ✓ Slip rings
- ✓ High-voltage connector
- ✓ Components contained within the covered motor power-supply assembly

High-voltage battery system

Specified battery-system protection, subject to the separate battery limits.

- ✓ Battery charger
- ✓ Battery-management and control unit
- ✓ Covered high-voltage battery components
- ✓ Individual battery-cell replacement, subject to the stated sub-limit
- ✗ Non-drive and auxiliary batteries are not covered

Steering, Braking and Suspension

Covered components are listed below. Normal wear, routine maintenance and the exclusions in your Vehicle Warranty Terms and Conditions remain applicable.

Ancillary electrics

Protection for factory-fitted supporting electrical components.

- ✓ Electronic control units
- ✓ Electric motors
- ✓ Switches
- ✓ Associated factory-fitted ancillary electrical components

Braking system

Protection for listed conventional and regenerative braking components.

- ✓ Brake-system sensors
- ✓ Brake switches
- ✓ Electronic brake-control units
- ✓ Hydraulic brake components
- ✓ Regenerative or energy-harvesting system
- ✗ Brake discs and pads are not covered

Steering

Protection for hydraulic and electric steering components.

- ✓ Steering rack
- ✓ Steering-column motor assembly
- ✓ Hydraulic steering units
- ✓ Associated covered steering control components

Suspension

Protection for the listed conventional suspension components.

- ✓ Coil springs
- ✓ Torsion bars
- ✓ Ball joints
- ✓ Suspension arms
- ✓ Associated covered suspension components

Cooling, Comfort and Security

Covered components are listed below. Normal wear, routine maintenance and the exclusions in your Vehicle Warranty Terms and Conditions remain applicable.

Battery and motor cooling

Protection for the components used to control battery and motor temperature.

- ✓ Cooling radiators
- ✓ Coolant tanks and reservoirs
- ✓ Covered cooling-system control components
- ✗ Coolant hoses and pipes are not covered

Climate control and heating

Protection for major cabin and powertrain climate-control components.

- ✓ Heat pump
- ✓ Air-conditioning system
- ✓ Climate-control components contained within the covered assemblies

Locks

Protection for the vehicle's major factory-fitted locks.

- ✓ Major door locks
- ✓ Boot and tailgate locks
- ✓ Factory-fitted powered locking components
- ✗ Accidental and malicious damage is not covered

High-Voltage Battery Cover

Individual high-voltage battery-cell replacement is limited to £1,000 per authorised claim, within the £3,000 overall maximum. Battery cover ends when the vehicle reaches 9 years of age or 70,000 miles, whichever happens first.

What the battery benefit is designed for

An eligible unexpected failure requiring replacement of one or more individual high-voltage drive-battery cells, subject to the sub-limit and prior authorisation.

What it does not cover

Normal loss of capacity, gradual degradation, environmental damage, discharge or fast-charge-related damage, and conventional or auxiliary batteries.

What is not covered

This warranty does not cover battery degradation, environmental battery damage, discharge or fast-charge-related damage, normal wear, accidental or malicious damage, routine maintenance, brake discs, brake pads, tyres, conventional vehicle batteries, auxiliary batteries, or other items excluded by the full warranty terms.

Additional Benefits

These benefits apply only in connection with a valid authorised claim and are included within the £3,000 claim limit — they are not paid on top of it.

Vehicle hire

Up to £45 per day including VAT, for up to 7 days, once repairs start — where the manufacturer repair time exceeds 8 working hours and ClearPath approval is obtained first.

Recovery

Up to £60 including VAT for recovery connected with a valid authorised claim.

European use

Cover extends within the European Union for up to 60 days in any 12-month period.

Renewal

Your warranty may be renewed at the end of the term, subject to approval and the vehicle remaining eligible.

What is not covered

This warranty does not cover battery degradation, environmental battery damage, discharge or fast-charge-related damage, general wear, accidental or reckless damage, routine servicing or maintenance, aftermarket or non-manufacturer-approved items or software, or consumables such as filters, batteries, tyres and fluids. The component-specific exclusions shown in this schedule also apply.

The claims rule

Get authority before repairs begin.

The three documents that make up your warranty

This schedule

Lists the components covered for your vehicle type.

Vehicle Warranty Terms and Conditions

The complete definitions, exclusions, limits and claim requirements. These take precedence if anything in this schedule appears to conflict with them.

Validation Certificate

Confirms your vehicle, cover level, period of cover and any vehicle-specific conditions.

Keep all three together. You will need your warranty number from the Validation Certificate whenever you contact us.

Important Additional Terms

This notice applies alongside the schedule above. It should be read together with your Vehicle Warranty Terms and Conditions, which take precedence if anything here appears to conflict.

Claims waiting period

No claim can be made within the first 14 days of your cover start date. This period runs alongside your 14 days cancellation period, so cover for claims begins once both have passed.

Number of claims and aggregate limit

There is no set limit on the number of authorised claims you can make during your period of cover. Each claim is assessed on its own merits, up to the £3,000 maximum contribution per authorised claim. An aggregate limit for the period of cover may be shown on your Validation Certificate; if none is shown, no aggregate limit applies.

Excess and labour rate

You pay a £100 excess on each authorised claim. We contribute towards labour at up to £100 per hour; where your repairer charges more than this, the difference is payable by you.

Betterment

Where a repair would leave a component materially better than its condition immediately before the failure — typically because the failed part was old, high-mileage, or already heavily worn — ClearPath may agree a reasonable customer contribution before work begins, in addition to your excess.

The nature of this warranty

This is a Mechanical Breakdown Warranty — a vehicle service contract, not a contract of insurance — provided on that basis. Full definitions and legal terms are set out in your Vehicle Warranty Terms and Conditions.

Governing law

This agreement is governed by the law of England and Wales. Nothing here affects your statutory consumer rights.
