What Is Covered

Detailed mechanical and electrical protection for the components that matter most. Read this schedule with your Vehicle Warranty Terms and Conditions and your Validation Certificate.

£3,000 maximum per authorised claim | £100 per hour labour rate

Your Cover at a Glance

This schedule shows the petrol and diesel vehicle components covered against an eligible Mechanical Breakdown.

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Powertrain Engine, manual and automatic transmission, clutch, turbo or supercharger, differential and driveline.	Driving systems Brakes, steering, suspension, cooling, heating and ventilation.

It must also fail because of an eligible Mechanical Breakdown. The exclusions and claim conditions in your Vehicle Warranty Terms and Conditions still apply.

Powertrain Protection

Covered components are listed below. Normal wear, routine maintenance and the exclusions in your Vehicle Warranty Terms and Conditions remain applicable.

Engine

Core protection for the major internal components that keep your engine running.

- ✓ Cylinder block, engine block and cylinder liners
- ✓ Crankshaft and camshaft
- ✓ Pistons, piston rings, gudgeon pins and connecting rods
- ✓ Main bearings and big-end bearings
- ✓ Balance shafts, internal gears and oil pump
- ✓ Timing chains, sprockets, guides and tensioners
- ✓ Variable camshaft timing assembly, including VANOS-type systems
- ✗ Cylinder head is covered, excluding burnt-out valves and valve seats

Automatic transmission

Protection for the main internal parts of conventional automatic transmissions.

- ✓ Automatic gears and internal gear assemblies
- ✓ Internal clutch packs
- ✓ Shafts and bearings
- ✓ Transmission bands
- ✓ Torque converter
- ✓ Transfer box, where fitted

Manual transmission

Protection for the principal internal moving parts of a manual gearbox.

- ✓ Gears and gear shafts
- ✓ Synchromesh hubs and assemblies
- ✓ Shaft bearings
- ✓ Selector forks
- ✓ Internal mechanical moving parts
- ✓ Transfer box, where fitted

Clutch

A wider clutch component schedule, while normal friction-material wear remains excluded.

- ✓ Pressure plate
- ✓ Friction plate
- ✓ Release bearing
- ✓ Ring gear
- ✓ Master cylinder and slave cylinder
- ✓ Clutch fork and operating lever
- ✓ Clutch pedal and clutch cable
- ✗ Worn facing material is not covered

Forced Induction and Final Drive

Covered components are listed below. Normal wear, routine maintenance and the exclusions in your Vehicle Warranty Terms and Conditions remain applicable.

Turbo and supercharger

Cover for forced-induction hardware, subject to the age and mileage limit below.

- ✓ Turbocharger
- ✓ Supercharger
- ✓ Intercooler
- ✓ Wastegate and wastegate control devices
- ✓ Internal turbo or supercharger failure components

Driveline

Cover for the components that transfer power from the gearbox to the road wheels.

- ✓ Drive shafts and half shafts
- ✓ Propeller shafts
- ✓ Centre bearings
- ✓ Constant-velocity joints
- ✓ Universal joints
- ✗ Rubber CV boots are not covered
- ✗ Wheel bearing wear is not covered

Differential

Protection for internal mechanical failure within the differential assembly.

- ✓ Crown wheel
- ✓ Pinion
- ✓ Internal gears
- ✓ Shafts and bearings
- ✓ Other internal mechanical moving parts

Cooling system

Protection for the components that regulate engine temperature.

- ✓ Radiator
- ✓ Engine oil cooler
- ✓ Water pump
- ✓ Cooling-fan motor and coupling
- ✓ Radiator-fan motor
- ✓ Engine-temperature sensor and gauge
- ✓ Thermostat and thermostat housing



Turbo and supercharger cover ends at 7 years or 80,000 miles

Cover for the turbocharger and supercharger applies until the vehicle reaches 7 years of age or 80,000 miles, whichever happens first. All other components in this schedule are unaffected by that limit.

Braking, Steering and Suspension

Covered components are listed below. Normal wear, routine maintenance and the exclusions in your Vehicle Warranty Terms and Conditions remain applicable.

Braking system

Mechanical and hydraulic brake components are protected; normal friction items are not.

- ✓ Brake servo unit
- ✓ Master cylinder
- ✓ Wheel cylinders
- ✓ Brake calipers
- ✓ Vacuum pump
- ✓ Brake pedal and operating mechanism
- ✓ Associated covered mechanical and hydraulic components
- ✗ Brake pads, shoes and discs are not covered

Suspension

Cover for key conventional and air-suspension components.

- ✓ Coil springs
- ✓ Pneumatic air springs
- ✓ Shock absorbers
- ✓ Ride-height actuators
- ✓ Regulator valves
- ✓ Track-control arms and linkages
- ✓ Suspension pump
- ✓ Ball joints and swivel joints
- ✗ Rubber suspension bushes are not covered

Steering

Protection for hydraulic and electric power-steering components.

- ✓ Steering rack and pinion
- ✓ Power-steering box
- ✓ Hydraulic pressure pipes
- ✓ Hydraulic power-steering pump
- ✓ Electric power-steering pump
- ✓ Power-steering reservoir
- ✓ Steering-column joints and bearings
- ✗ Track-rod end wear is not covered

Heating and ventilation

Cover for the main cabin heating and ventilation hardware.

- ✓ Heater matrix
- ✓ Heater fan and blower motor
- ✓ Heater box
- ✓ Vent controls
- ✓ Associated covered mechanical and electrical operating components

Electrical, Fuel and Air Conditioning

Covered components are listed below. Normal wear, routine maintenance and the exclusions in your Vehicle Warranty Terms and Conditions remain applicable.

Electrical system

Broad protection for many factory-fitted electrical components.

- ✓ Starter motor and alternator
- ✓ Voltage regulator
- ✓ Ignition coils and electronic ignition amplifier
- ✓ Factory-fitted sensors
- ✓ Relays and switches
- ✓ Electric-window regulators and motors
- ✓ Front and rear wiper and washer motors
- ✓ Factory-fitted sunroof and cabriolet motors
- ✓ Cruise-control unit
- ✓ Headlamp motors
- ✓ Horn
- ✓ Multi-function indicator stalk switch
- ✓ Alarm control unit and siren

Air conditioning

Cover for the main factory-fitted air-conditioning components.

- ✓ Air-conditioning compressor
- ✓ Condenser
- ✓ Receiver and evaporator
- ✓ High-pressure pipes
- ✗ Flexible hoses are not covered

Fuel system

Protection for fuel delivery, injection and metering components.

- ✓ Fuel lift pump
- ✓ Fuel pump and injection pump
- ✓ Fuel injectors
- ✓ Fuel-level sender unit
- ✓ Throttle body
- ✓ Throttle potentiometer
- ✓ Airflow meter and airflow sensor

Control units and wiring

Protection for listed factory-fitted electronic control hardware and wiring.

- ✓ Engine control unit (ECU)
- ✓ Rear electrical centre (REC)
- ✓ Under-bonnet electrical centre (UEC)
- ✓ Solid-state control units
- ✓ Wiring looms
- ✓ Resistance circuits
- ✗ Water damage, corrosion and chewed wiring are not covered

Locks, Seals and Casings

Covered components are listed below. Normal wear, routine maintenance and the exclusions in your Vehicle Warranty Terms and Conditions remain applicable.

Locks

Protection for factory-fitted mechanical and powered locking components.

- ✓ Central-locking solenoids
- ✓ Door and tailgate handles
- ✓ Lock barrels
- ✓ Door, boot and tailgate catches
- ✗ **Accidental or forced-entry damage is not covered**

Seals and gaskets

Specified seals and gaskets are covered where an immediate major repair is required.

- ✓ Cylinder-head gasket
- ✓ Engine oil seals causing a major oil leak
- ✓ Gearbox oil seals causing a major oil leak
- ✓ Removal of the engine or gearbox must be essential
- ✗ **Worn seals, collars and shafts are not covered**

Casings

A casing is covered when it is damaged directly by the failure of a covered internal component.

- ✓ Engine casing
- ✓ Gearbox casing
- ✓ Differential casing
- ✓ Transfer-box casing
- ✓ Other casings housing a listed covered component

Additional Benefits

These benefits apply only in connection with a valid authorised claim and are included within the £3,000 claim limit — they are not paid on top of it.

Vehicle hire

Up to £45 per day including VAT, for up to 7 days, once repairs start — where the manufacturer repair time exceeds 8 working hours and ClearPath approval is obtained first.

Recovery

Up to £60 including VAT for recovery connected with a valid authorised claim.

European use

Cover extends within the European Union for up to 60 days in any 12-month period.

Renewal

Your warranty may be renewed at the end of the term, subject to approval and the vehicle remaining eligible.

What is not covered

This warranty does not cover accidental or reckless damage, general wear, routine servicing or maintenance, aftermarket or non-manufacturer-approved items or software, or consumables such as filters, spark or glow plugs, batteries, exhausts, auxiliary belts, tyres and fluids. The component-specific exclusions shown in this schedule also apply.



Contact ClearPath before any repair or substantial dismantling begins

A claim must be assessed and an authorisation number issued before covered work starts. Call 020 4577 0371. Work carried out without an authorisation number cannot be paid.

Claims and Support

If something goes wrong, our team will explain the next steps and work directly with your repairer. Have your warranty number, vehicle registration and current mileage ready when you contact us.

The claims rule

Get authority before repairs begin.

The three documents that make up your warranty

This schedule

Lists the components covered for your vehicle type.

Vehicle Warranty Terms and Conditions

The complete definitions, exclusions, limits and claim requirements. These take precedence if anything in this schedule appears to conflict with them.

Validation Certificate

Confirms your vehicle, cover level, period of cover and any vehicle-specific conditions.

Keep all three together. You will need your warranty number from the Validation Certificate whenever you contact us.

Important Additional Terms

This notice applies alongside the schedule above. It should be read together with your Vehicle Warranty Terms and Conditions, which take precedence if anything here appears to conflict.

Claims waiting period

No claim can be made within the first 14 days of your cover start date. This period runs alongside your 14 days cancellation period, so cover for claims begins once both have passed.

Number of claims and aggregate limit

There is no set limit on the number of authorised claims you can make during your period of cover. Each claim is assessed on its own merits, up to the £3,000 maximum contribution per authorised claim. An aggregate limit for the period of cover may be shown on your Validation Certificate; if none is shown, no aggregate limit applies.

Excess and labour rate

You pay a £100 excess on each authorised claim. We contribute towards labour at up to £100 per hour; where your repairer charges more than this, the difference is payable by you.

Betterment

Where a repair would leave a component materially better than its condition immediately before the failure — typically because the failed part was old, high-mileage, or already heavily worn — ClearPath may agree a reasonable customer contribution before work begins, in addition to your excess.

The nature of this warranty

This is a Mechanical Breakdown Warranty — a vehicle service contract, not a contract of insurance — provided on that basis. Full definitions and legal terms are set out in your Vehicle Warranty Terms and Conditions.

Governing law

This agreement is governed by the law of England and Wales. Nothing here affects your statutory consumer rights.
